Great news, the Pierce Hall renovation project is moving into its next phase! CNAS, campus leadership and staff are coordinating and communicating frequently to help effect smooth transitions and relocations related to this project. As we move closer to the start of construction, we will be providing further clarification around the details of the process. We recommend that the below webpage be your “go to” resource for project information and guidance surrounding this process. All relevant communications regarding the Project will be saved here for ease of future access, including presentations, project timelines, etc.

What to Expect in the upcoming weeks and months?

1. **Presentation.** A presentation outlining the details of the Pierce Hall renovation project will be scheduled in the upcoming weeks. Members of Campus Planning, Architects and Engineers, Space Management will be on hand along with the College leadership to present current project information and answer questions about the process. The meeting will cover at least the following topics:
 - Project Scope
 - Timelines
 - Impacts to end users
 - Move management

2. **Email updates.** Effective October 2017, monthly updates will be generated via email to a targeted group of impacted end users. The emails will provide general updates surrounding all aspects of the project (Approvals and bidding process, move management and construction)
3. **Other Communications.** Over time, end users will receive updates through various types of communication methods such as on-site building notices and QR codes (Quick Response Code). The QR code is a scanned image that links to a website. The Pierce project QR code will link to the contractor's website for details surrounding the progress of construction.

Key Milestones:

Fall/Winter 2017 & Spring 2018 – Project bidding/Approvals and move management coordination

April 2018 – Start of construction for Phase 1 (12 months) which includes:

- North Wing and South Wing: MEP (Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing) Infrastructure upgrades on all floors
- North Wing: Interior renovation all floors
- South Wing: General Assignment classroom
- Exterior improvements

March 2019 – End of construction for Phase 1

July 2019 – Start of construction for Phase 2 (18 months) which includes:

- Center Wing: MEP (Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing) Infrastructure upgrades on all floors
- Center Wing: Interior renovation first floor
- Restroom upgrades

September 2020 – End of construction for Phase 2
